The Team organises activities and programmes for the involvement of St. Patrick's parishioners of all ages, and tries to recognise them as "family in our church". To date, we have:

- Brought together the sick, elderly and disabled shut-ins for uplifting Healing Services;
- Organised a Mother and Daughter programme where both were able to discuss challenges and pleasurable joys of the family setting;
- Convened energising dance sessions with the participation of groups and non-Catholics;
- Arranged several Family Masses with Fellowship afterwards, in an effort to foster friendly relationships among members of the congregation.

In collaboration with the Church, the Team celebrates Mother's Day and Father's Day with gifts, prayers and songs. We recognise families by encouraging them to introduce themselves to the congregation and share their love for their faith. We have invited families to spend "quiet time" in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and to participate in the Advent Candle-Lighting Ceremony. We celebrate Christmas by giving back to the parishioners for their support during the year. Our vision for St Patrick's is To Build Strong Christian Families Through Unity. We hope for:

- A vibrant community of faith, growing spiritually through worship, bible study and service;
- Events and socials that would bring parishioners together in unity and build stronger friendships;
- Projects and initiatives to address the needs of parishioners;
- An active Youth Ministry.

Despite the challenges and obstacles experienced over the years, the Family Life Team has successfully executed several enjoyable and interesting events. This is done through dedication to our mission, love of our Faith and our church, and unity through prayer. We are truly blessed through this Ministry!
